

CERTIFICATE OF PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCE

TRANSPORT MANAGER - FREIGHT AND PASSENGER OPERATIONS

Overview:

A requirement for the granting of a standard 'O' Licence for both freight and passenger transport operations is that the licence holder either holds, or has access to the services of someone who holds, a Certificate of Professional Competence (CPC). Current legislation imposes restrictions on the number of operator licences and vehicles on which an external associate CPC holder can be named.

The CPC is a qualification issued on behalf of all EU national transport departments (Transport Malta). The qualifications are currently assessed through a combination of multiple choice and case study examinations.

Course content:

The new format for, both freight and passenger involves seven days of tuition and an optional one-day revision workshop concluding with the examination day.

Everyone involved in road transport who operates vehicles for hire and reward must demonstrate evidence of professional competence. The Operator CPC qualification confirms that the holder has acquired the relevant knowledge and skills to carry out his or her duties and is able to comply with the latest regulations.

Who this course is for:

These courses are aimed at transport managers or those aspiring to this role who will have responsibility for the holding of an organisation's Operator's Licence.

Course dates:

Courses are held for Passenger Transport and Road Haulage, International Road Haulage and International Passenger Transport
