

The IOSH Managing Environmental Responsibilities is a course designed for those people who need to manage environmental issues in compliance with their organisation's policy, legislation and best practice.

Entry Criteria: There are no formal entry criteria for admission to the IOSH Managing Environmental Responsibilities programme.

Course Content: The list of subjects covered includes:

- An introduction to environmental issues and their management
- Legal requirements
- Water
- Air
- Land
- Environmental management systems

Assessment: All candidates must complete a short assessment paper and a practical assignment. These are moderated by IOSH and an IOSH Certificate will be awarded to successful candidates.
