

The IOSH Working Safely is a course designed for all types of people in the full range of business organisations. The personnel to attend this course are process workers, office workers, engineers, supervisory and management in all types of organisations, who need an initial understanding of health and safety at work.

Entry Criteria: There are no formal entry criteria for admission to the IOSH Working Safely programme.

Course Content: The list of subjects covered includes:

- Hazard, risk and control
- Safety management systems
- General housekeeping
- Electrical safety
- Fire prevention
- Manual Handling
- Work equipment
- Vehicle movement
- Display screen equipment
- Noise
- Chemicals and substances

Assessment: A short assessment paper is set on the course. This is moderated by IOSH and an IOSH Certificate will be awarded to successful candidates.
