

TRAFFIC SIGNING: FROM FIRST PRINCIPLES TO BEST PRACTICE

An eight-week evening seminar course

Overview:

The eight-week course begins with a basic introduction to the Traffic Signs, Regulations and General Directions (TSRGD) and covers all the major categories of signs. Specific sessions deal with how to address the design, location, installation and illumination of traffic signing in the most sensitive manner and choosing the most appropriate material type. By holding the lectures outside of standard working hours, we are able to keep costs low whilst providing high quality training to the delegates with a minimum of unproductive time to the employer.

Course content:

This course covers the following:

1. Introduction to the TSRGD
2. Regulatory and warning signs
3. Signing systems and strategy
4. Direction sign design
5. Traffic sign face materials and specification
6. Signing in the public realm
7. Road markings
8. Location, installation and illumination

Benefits:

The learning outcome is to provide those working in and around the fields of highways design and traffic management with grounding in the theory and practice of effective traffic signing. Delegates achieving a minimum of 75% attendance of the lecture series will receive a certificate of attendance. In addition completion of this eight-week course will count towards the additional hours of learning necessary to achieve the CILT Certificate in Traffic and Transport.
